Brothers and Sisters,

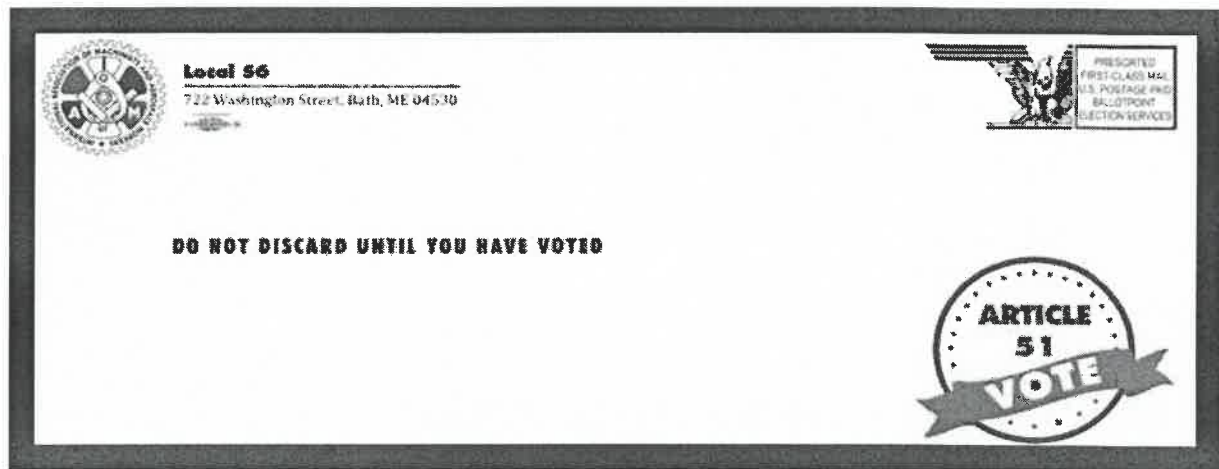
