Candidates for elective office must be members of the Local Lodge for at least one year at the time of nomination and free from delinquency to the Local, District and Grand Lodges, and shall be working at the trade as defined in Article II, Section 4 for 6 months prior thereto in order to qualify for nomination and election. To be nominated for Chief Stewards and Grievance Committees, you must have attended 50% of the regular lodge meetings held during the 12-month period ending the date of the close of nominations in order to qualify as a candidate.

Absentee ballots shall be issued and voted in accordance with the provisions set forth in the IAM Constitution Article II, Section 3 and in compliance with the following provisions: (1) A written request for an absentee ballot must be delivered in person by the requestee or received by USPS mail to the Recording Secretary not later than 30 days before the election; (2) the request must contain the member’s full, current address; (3) if the records of the Local Lodge indicate that the applicant is eligible to vote in the election, the Recording Secretary and Secretary-Treasurer shall, within 5 days of the close of nominations, or as soon thereafter as ballots are available, mail the absentee ballot; and (4) if, in the judgment of the Recording Secretary and Secretary-Treasurer, the member is not entitled to vote by absentee ballot, the member will be so notified in writing within 10 days of receipt of the request for an absentee ballot.

Only members in good standing of Local Lodge S6 will be permitted to vote in the elections. The candidate who receives the highest number of votes for each office shall be declared elected. Each elected candidate will serve a three-year term.

In accordance with the IAM Constitution, any member entitled to receive an absentee ballot shall make a written request that must be delivered in person by the requestee or received by USPS mail to the Recording Secretary, not later than 30 days before the election at “722 Washington St, Bath Maine 04530”.
