On June 19<sup>th</sup> we began going through all the Memorandums of Agreement (MOA) with the Company. All MOAs are discussed and either removed or carried forward. Any MOA we cannot agree on gets brought to the bargaining table during negotiations. Negotiations officially begin on July 26<sup>th</sup> and will continue until we reach an agreement with the Company. We hope the Company presents an offer that reflects the hard work and determination the membership provides for the shipyard. We won't know the entire picture until negotiations begin but updates will be shared as soon as possible. Until then, we thank everyone for their patience. We will keep you informed so we can stand together strong and united!
