The 2nd Shift Shop Steward election for the W12, S40, and L40 classification will be held next Thursday; 11/9/23. Location/times remain the same.

Local S6 on the Picket Line in Baileyville

Last week representatives from Local S6 joined members of IAM Local 1490, SEIU Local 330-3, and Millwrights Local 1121 on their picket line. They extended their gratitude for making the trip up and we appreciated their warm welcome. Local S6 is proud to stand shoulder to shoulder with these brave workers. They are putting a lot on the line to maintain their rights and dignity as experienced mechanics. The strike is entering its fourth week, and a federal mediator is being called in to meet with the company and Negotiating Committee next week.

The strike is over proposed contract language that would turn all members into general mechanics. This kind of language waters down the experience of the workforce in a poor attempt to devalue the skills of senior mechanics just to save a few dollars. Additionally, it would empower an inexperienced management group to put workers in unsafe situations. These courageous workers are facing a thinly veiled attempt to break their union. They have our full support. United we’re one, divided we’re done.
